From the Administrator's Desk.....

Saint Luke's Gospel is often referred to as "The Gospel of Mercy," because it reveals God's love for sinners, the outcast, the downtrodden, and the forgotten in a very powerful way. There are several parables of mercy present in Luke's Gospel that are not present in the others: most notably the parable of the Good Samaritan, and the parable of the Prodigal Son.

In today's Gospel, we see the parable of the Prodigal Son paired with two others: the parable of the Lost Sheep, and the parable of the Lost Coin. All three of these parables are told in response to the grumbling of the Pharisees, who were complaining that Jesus welcomed sinners and ate with them. By telling these parables one after the other, Jesus drives home the point that God is merciful, and that he rejoices when sinners recognize their need for repentance and return to God. "For there will be more joy in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who need no repentance."

I often find myself quoting this passage of scripture in the Confessional, especially when a person acknowledges that it has been a long time since they have approached the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It is important that we help people to recognize the gift of God's mercy, and to recognize that he is always calling us to follow him more faithfully in our lives. We can do this just as Jesus did: by welcoming others into relationship with God, and helping them to experience God's love and mercy in their lives.

While these parables seemingly focus on those who have strayed away for some time, it is also important to remember that God's mercy is no less powerful for those who regularly approach the sacraments, and regularly strive to do what is right. Often, we can become discouraged when we find ourselves repeatedly committing the same sins. It can be difficult to continually approach God and ask for forgiveness, because of our own shame and feelings of guilt. Here, we can take comfort in the words of Pope Francis. In his Apostolic Exhortation *Evangelii Gaudium* (The Joy of the Gospel), he writes: "God never tires of forgiving us; we are the ones who tire of seeking his mercy. Christ, who told us to forgive one another "seventy times seven" has given us his example: he has forgiven us seventy times seven. Time and time again he bears us on his shoulders."

Throughout this week, I encourage you to take time in prayer to be mindful of the presence of the mercy of God in your life, and to give thanks to God for the gift of that mercy.

LIVING AS A SYNODAL CHURCH

Our synod theme for this week is "Sharing Responsibility for our Common Mission". Our common mission comes from the lips of Jesus in Matt. 28:19, "Go and make disciples of all nations" and is directed to all of us. We are co-responsible for the mission of the Church in the world. We trust that when God calls us, he equips us to fulfill the call. Through our baptism and confirmation, the Holy Spirit pours his 7-fold gifts into us, that we might grow in our personal rela-tionship to Christ to be faithful disciples. To fulfill our mission, each of us is called by God to discern the particular gifts and charisms we have been given beyond our talents, our developed skills and our personalities; so that we prayerfully open ourselves to cooperate with the Holy Spirit, that he might work through us to draw others to encounters with God. When we know what our spiritual gifts are and how they work together we can further discern the ways in which God might be asking us to use those gifts in our circumstances of life. We know where we are best suited to give of ourselves, and where others may be more gifted. In fact, we begin to identify and help others discern their own particular gifts. Our parish has worked with a process from the Catherine of Siena Institute, entitled "Called and Gifted",
