

t felt so good to cross the Ambassador ■ Bridge and be back home again, after FROM THE my holidays! I enjoyed seeing family and PASTOR'S DESK friends, but knew that Windsor has become my home. Thank you for that gift. As a

Basilian, I have been assigned to many different places for ministry. In fact, even as a newly ordained priest I had already been in Rochester, New York, in Texas, then to Toronto, back to Texas, and was getting ready to move to Cali, Colombia. Fr. Bob Klem, the priest who preached at my first Mass mentioned how it was from North to South, from East to West: It was a cross—and it was a blessing. With each move since then (and there have been more than I would prefer to count!), Fr. Bob's words come back to me. There is difficulty and sadness in leaving a place; there is the difficulty of the move itself, and getting to know someplace new. And then, I feel like I belong. I feel that this is home. I know that I am blessed. I thank each of you for being a blessing to me.

When I look at this weekend's readings, I realize that my crosses have been so tiny compared to Jesus'; I also realize that they are tiny compared to some of yours. Yet, part of the Christian reality is that it does not matter how big a cross may be. Part of an authentic cross seems to be that it is not something I choose; it is imposed on me. And how I embrace that cross makes the difference between living in misery or experiencing new life—true blessing!

I think that part of what drew me to Assumption is that this community—YOU—have been living a cross, with the closure of parishes for many of you, and now the closure of Assumption church. Together, we can allow God to transform that cross into blessings beyond our imagining.

What is the Church?

What is the Church? The Church is the people of God, the Body of Christ on earth. The church building is the house of the people of God, and therefore the house of God. It has become sacred because it is where Eucharistic worship takes place. The work of the people, *liturgy*, sanctifies the space as it makes Christ present through the word, through the Eucharist, through the ministers, and through the people assembled. After gathering for worship and being nourished by the Eucharist we are then sent out into the world to be the Church, the Body of Christ in our own place and time... our homes, workplaces, schools, etc. That's quite a challenge, knowing wherever we are, the Church is! Does that influence how we speak and act? It should! If we only act like we are Church when in a church building, we've missed the point.


