Worship Bags

"Worship Bags" for children are available at the entrance to the churches. They contain bulletins with pictures for colouring, puzzles, and games related to that Sunday's readings and the saint of the week. Children are welcome to work on one of these and then bring it home. Let it be a starter to a conversation between the family and the child about the readings or the saint. They will occasionally contain prayer cards and other conversation starters. The bags also contain crayons, markers, and pens. Please be sure to return the bag with these in it for use by another child.

Liturgy Matters

You wear some interesting things. What are they called and what do they mean?

Interesting indeed, but in the Greco-Roman world these vestments were common.

- Alb: long white robe that can be worn by any of the baptized.
- Stole: long cloth band worn around the neck, a sign of priestly authority.
- Chasuble: outer, poncho-like garment that is a sign of Christ's charity, worn by a priest when he celebrates Mass.
- Dalmatic: outer garment with wide sleeves worn by a deacon at Mass.

These vestments allow for some variety based on culture and personal preference. The colors are determined by the liturgical season and sacrament being celebrated.
