

TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY

September 23, 2012

Wis. 2:12,17-20; Ps. 53; James 3:16-4:3; Mark 9-30-37

For a second time, immediately after his transfiguration, Jesus predicts his passion. The disciples listen in disbelief; they do not want to hear. Their argument over rank shows how remote their thoughts are from willingness to suffer with the Master. Jesus counters their struggle for power by insisting that the greatest among them must become the ser-

vant of all. Jesus presents as example for discipleship a child, one who had no importance in the ancient world. Christ has aligned himself with those who have no prestige or importance: if we welcome them, Jesus promises we shall find ourselves welcoming him and the Father also. Do we try to reconcile discipleship with a struggle for prestige? The letter of James speaks plainly of the bitter fruits of jealousy and ambition. In the first reading, the echoes of Jesus' own suffering remind us that he was persecuted by those who seemed to be just. Do we persecute other believers? Or, are we ready to be a servant Church, accepting a share in Jesus' suffering and humiliation in order to share his glory?
