A Transitus Service includes recalling St. Francis' final hours, storytelling, prayer and singing, keeping alive the spirituality that Francis and his early companions left us.

## Liturgy Matters

### What do you mean by "liturgical season?"

Each year the Mystery of Christ unfolds across "seasons." The readings, music, liturgical environment, homilies...reflect the season.

- **Advent:** begins four Sundays before Christmas, with hopeful preparation for the coming of Christ at the culmination of time and recalling his coming in time at the birth of Jesus.
- **Christmastime:** begins on Christmas eve, goes through Epiphany, and ends when we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord, the three manifestations of Christ.
- **Ordinary Time (I):** an order of scripture readings tracing Jesus' public ministry.
- **Lent:** a 40 day penitential period leading to the Triduum.
- **The Easter Triduum:** one liturgical celebration spread over 3 days commemorating the Last Supper, the Crucifixion, and the Easter Vigil.
- **Easter:** a 50 day celebration of Jesus' resurrection, Ascension, and gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost.
- **Ordinary Time (II):** a continuation of the order of Jesus public ministry, concluding with the Solemnity of Christ, the King of the Universe
