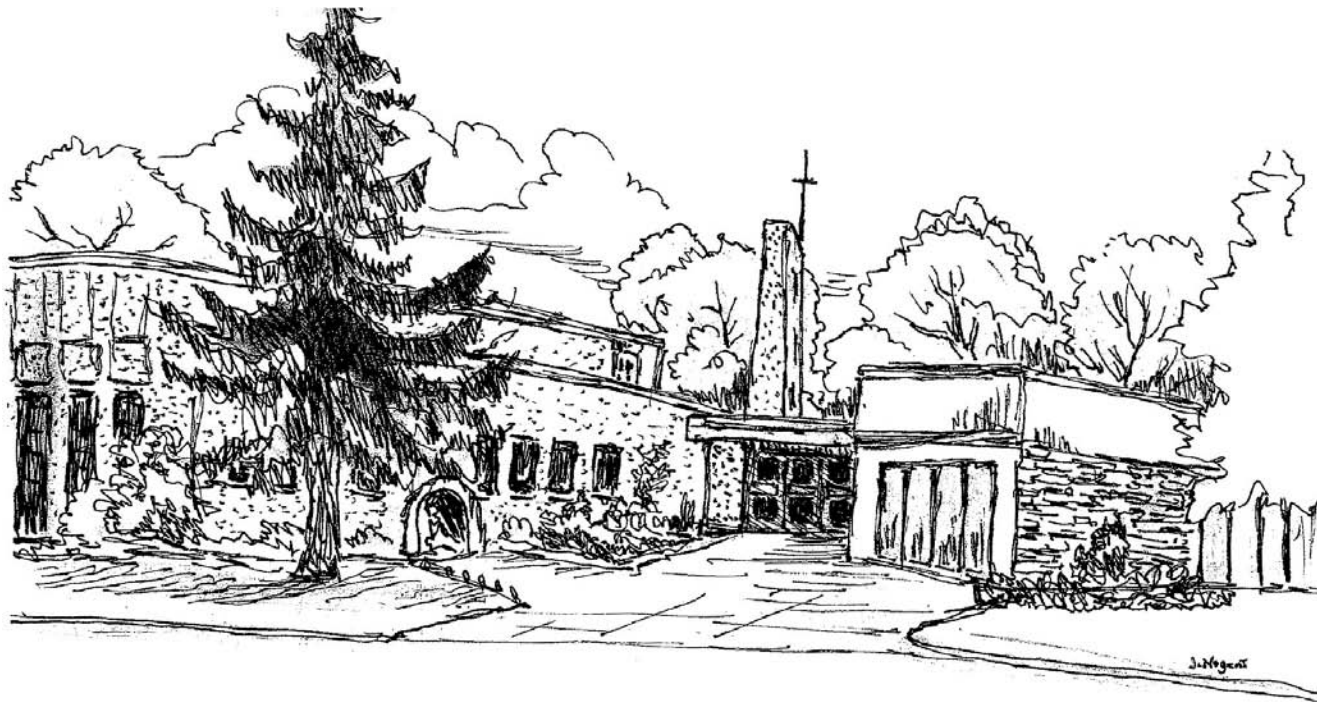

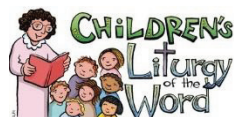

## THE WORLD DAY OF THE SICK AND THE RITE OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK

Each year on February 11, the Church observes the **World Day of the Sick**, a day that coincides with the **Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes**. This day invites us to reflect on Christ's compassionate care for the sick and suffering, and on the Church's enduring mission to bring healing, comfort, and hope to those in need. From its earliest days, the Christian community has taken seriously the call found in the Letter of James: "Are there any who are sick among you? Let them call for the elders of the Church, and let them pray over them, anointing them with oil in the name of the Lord."

**The Rite of the Anointing of the Sick** is one of the Church's seven sacraments and is a powerful sign of God's loving presence in times of illness, weakness, or serious health challenge. Far from being reserved only for the moment of death, this sacrament is intended to strengthen the faithful whenever serious illness, advanced age, or an upcoming medical procedure, places a person in particular need of God's grace. Through this rite, the Church continues Christ's healing ministry, offering prayer, sacramental grace, and the reassurance that no one suffers alone.

At the heart of the rite is prayer. The priest, acting on behalf of the Church, prays for the sick person's healing, peace, and trust in the Lord. The laying on of hands recalls the gestures of Jesus himself, who touched the sick and restored them. The anointing with the **Oil of the Sick**, blessed by the bishop at the **Chrism Mass**, marks the person as entrusted to God's care. As the priest anoints the forehead and hands, he prays that the Lord will grant strength, relief from suffering, forgiveness of sins, and, if it be God's will, restoration to health.

The grace of this sacrament is both spiritual and, at times, physical. It brings comfort in anxiety, courage in fear, and hope in the face of uncertainty. It unites the suffering of the sick person with the saving work of Christ, reminding us that even in weakness, God is at work. For some, this grace leads to recovery; for others, it provides peace, endurance, and readiness to face whatever lies ahead.

**The Anointing of the Sick is available to the faithful at any time of serious illness and should not be delayed until the final hours of life. Families are encouraged to contact the parish early, so that the sacrament may be celebrated prayerfully and without urgency, allowing the sick person to participate fully in the grace and comfort the Church desires to offer.**

This sacrament also reminds the entire parish community of its responsibility to care for the vulnerable. When one member suffers, all are called to respond with prayer, compassion, and practical support. As we observe the World Day of the Sick, may we renew our commitment to accompany those who are ill, to encourage them to receive the sacraments, and to trust always in the healing mercy of Christ, who walks with us in every season of life.
