THE FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING

The Feast of Christ the King, formally known as the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, is one of the Church's most recent solemnities, yet it proclaims one of the most ancient truths of Christian faith: that Jesus Christ is Lord of all creation, reigning over every human heart and the entire cosmos. Celebrated on the final Sunday of the liturgical year, it brings the Church's calendar to a close by directing our eyes toward the ultimate fulfillment of God's kingdom at the end of time.

The feast was instituted by **Pope Pius XI** in 1925 through his encyclical *Quas Primas*. At that time, the world was still reeling from the devastation of World War I. Many nations were turning toward secularism, nationalism, and ideologies that rejected the moral authority of God. Pius XI saw these trends as symptoms of a deeper spiritual crisis, the denial of Christ's kingship over human life and society. By establishing the feast, he sought to remind the faithful that peace and justice cannot be achieved apart from Christ, who is the true ruler of hearts and nations. The pope hoped that this annual celebration would strengthen Christians in their witness and reassert the moral and spiritual foundation of public life.

Originally observed on the last Sunday of October, just before All Saints' Day, the feast was moved in 1969 by Pope St. Paul VI to the final Sunday of the liturgical year. This placement gives it eschatological (or end times) significance: it points to Christ's return in glory and the completion of God's saving work. The readings for the day, often depicting Christ as the shepherd-king who judges the nations, invite believers to see His reign not as one of power and domination, but of mercy, truth, and service.

For Christians today, the Feast of Christ the King remains profoundly relevant. In a world still marked by conflict, division, and the pursuit of self-interest, this feast calls believers to recognize that ultimate authority belongs not to any political system or ideology, but to the crucified and risen Lord. Christ's kingship is not imposed by force; it is accepted in freedom and lived through love. He reigns from the cross, showing that true power is expressed in self-sacrifice and compassion.

To celebrate this feast is to renew our allegiance to Christ and to allow His values to shape our lives. It challenges us to seek first the kingdom of God, in our families, workplaces, and communities, and to bear witness to justice, forgiveness, and peace. When Christians live under Christ's rule of love, they help to make His kingdom visible in the world.

As the liturgical year concludes with this solemnity, the Church reminds us that history itself is moving toward Christ, the Alpha and the Omega. His kingdom, unlike any earthly one, will have no end. To proclaim "Christ is King" is to affirm our hope that in Him, all creation will find its unity, peace, and fulfillment.
