THE SPIRITUALITY OF FALL: A SEASON OF GRATITUDE

Now that we have celebrated Thanksgiving and signs of Fall are everywhere, creation itself seems to invite us into reflection and praise. The changing colors, the cooling air, and the gradual quieting of the world around us all speak of God's presence moving gently through time. Fall is a sacred teacher, reminding us that every season of life, growth, abundance, surrender, and rest holds its own grace. At the heart of it all is gratitude: the prayer of those who notice.

Thanksgiving, in its truest sense, is not simply a holiday but a posture of the soul. It calls us to recognize the generosity of God in all things, in harvest and in hardship, in fullness and in loss. **St. Francis of Assisi**, whose joyful spirituality embraced the whole of creation, shows us this way of seeing. In the *Canticle of the Creatures*, he praised God for "Brother Sun" and "Sister Moon," for wind, fire, and even "Sister Death." Francis would surely have sung of "Brother Autumn," whose falling leaves and golden light proclaim that beauty and surrender are intertwined. To live in thanksgiving, for Francis, was to live in harmony with the Creator's rhythm, to find holiness not only in the blossoming but also in the fading.

Fr. Henri Nouwen, the beloved spiritual writer, reminds us that gratitude is a deliberate practice. It is not dependent on how pleasant our circumstances may be but arises from the awareness that we are held in love. "To be grateful," Nouwen wrote, "is to recognize the love of God in everything He has given us." Autumn, with its quiet melancholy, invites us to that recognition. When we watch the trees release their leaves, we learn how to let go with grace, trusting that God's life continues even in what seems like loss. Gratitude becomes a form of trust, a way of saying that God is present in every turning of the year.

Irish poet and theologian **John O'Donohue** saw autumn as "a time of balance and belonging," a threshold season where light and darkness meet. In his Celtic vision, Fall

reveals the beauty of transition, the truth that every ending carries the seed of beginning. To bless this season is to honor both abundance and change.

To live the spirituality of Fall, then, is to live gratefully, to give thanks for abundance while honoring loss, to see God's artistry in both the harvest and the fading light. Our celebration of Thanksgiving is not just for a day; it is the soul's response to the mystery of change. In the golden quiet of autumn, gratitude becomes our prayer, and creation itself our cathedral.
