Bible Study Resumes

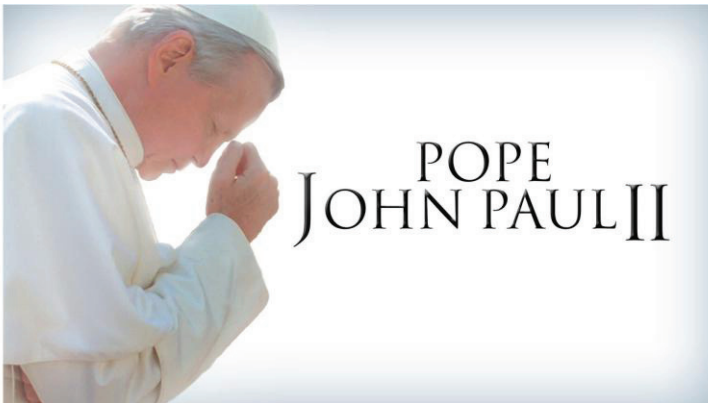
