Installation of the 10th Bishop of Hamilton

Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, C.S.M.A.

The Installation of His Excellency, Bishop Joseph Dabrowski, as the 10th Bishop of Hamilton will take place on Monday, February 2, at the Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King in Hamilton. This will be an invitation-only liturgical celebration. The Mass will be **livestreamed**. Please visit <https://hamiltondiocese.com/> for more details.

The Most Reverend Joseph Dabrowski was born in 1964, the second of five children, and grew up in Wysoka Strzyżowska, a village in the south of Poland. He was ordained to the priesthood on 4 May 1991 in Italy at the Pontifical Sanctuary of Santa Maria ad Rupes. He was assigned to join the Michaelite community in London, Ontario. On April 2, 2023, Bishop Dabrowski was appointed by Pope Francis, and he was then installed on June 29, 2023, as the 14th Bishop of Charlottetown.

We invite everyone to keep our new Bishop in your prayers as he begins his episcopal ministry among us, asking that he may be warmly welcomed and faithfully supported in this new chapter of service. Prayer cards of Bishop Joseph Dabrowski are available at the table at the back of the church.
