On the weekend of **June 14/15**, we will welcome Sister Clarisse Ramjika from Cameroon who will be visiting our parish for the annual Mission Co-operative appeal. **The Little Sisters of Mary Immaculate of Gulu** (LSMIG) are an indigenous Congregation of Catholic Sisters founded in 1936 in the Archdiocese of Gulu, in Northern Uganda (East Africa). Their mission is to witness to the love of Jesus Christ to the poor and most vulnerable members of the society. Currently, LSMIG Sisters are serving the people of northern Uganda who are emerging from a nearly 30 year devastating civil war while dealing with influx of refugees from South Sudan and the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The sisters are responding courageously with limited resources to the needs of refugee child-mothers and children in the refugee camps. The money raised from the Mission appeal will be used to break the cycle of child motherhood in the refugee camps and to impart our Catholic values of God's love and kindness to refugee children. The sisters graciously ask for your prayers and financial support and thank you for your generosity.

Farewell Coffee Sunday for Fr. John Schnurr

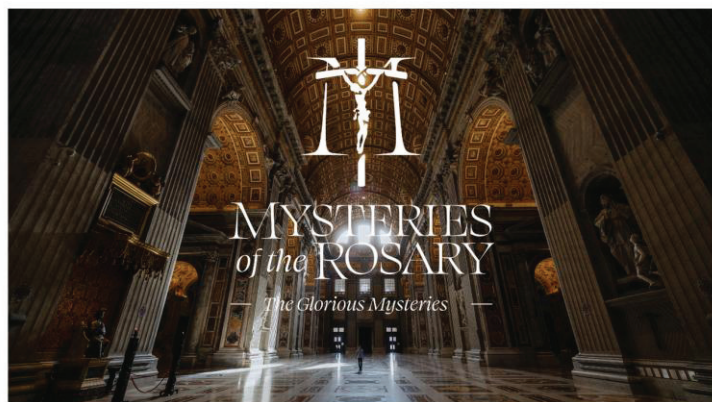
