The Heart of Jesus: Love that Heals and Transforms

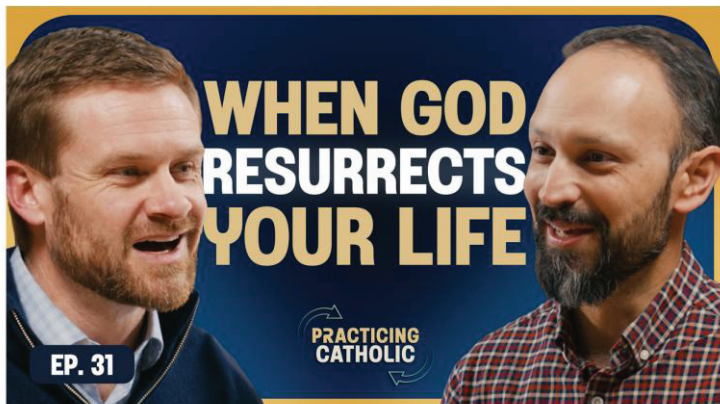
