Spiritual Renewal for Easter

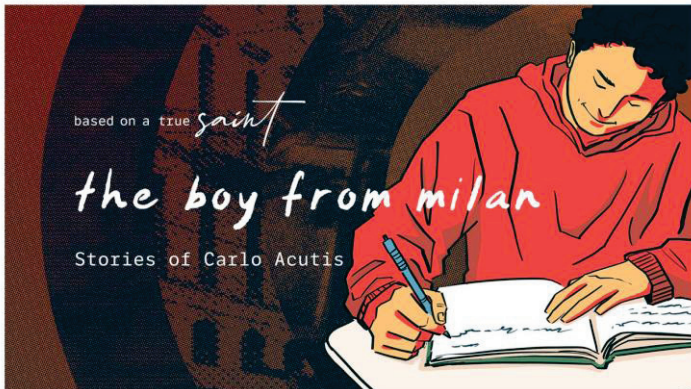
