# MEANING OF BEING "POOR IN SPIRIT" (Mt 5:3)

[Those who are truly "poor in spirit" (Mt 5:3)] are people who do not flaunt their achievements before God. They do not stride into God's presence as if they were partners able to engage with Him on an equal footing; they do not lay claim to a reward for what they have done. These are people who know that their poverty also has an interior dimension; they are lovers who simply want to let God bestow His gifts upon them and thereby to live in inner harmony with God's nature and word. The saying of Saint Therese of Lisieux about one day standing before God with empty hands, and holding them open to Him, describes the spirit of these poor ones of God: They come with empty hands; not with hands that grasp and clutch, but with hands that open and give and thus are ready to receive from God's bountiful goodness.
