

Dear Parishioners.

The season of Advent is here—a beautiful time of hope, preparation, and love. Advent is God's gentle way of telling us, "Slow down. Make room for My Son." As we prepare for Christmas, let us ask one simple question: *Is there room in my heart for Jesus? * When Mary and Joseph arrived in Bethlehem, they could not find a place to stay.
