

The WDMR takes place annually on the last Sunday of September and is an occasion to express concern for different vulnerable people on the move; to pray for them as they face many challenges; and to increase awareness about the opportunities that migration offers.

This year also marks the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's final report, which reminds us of the need to continue walking with and learning from Indigenous Peoples in a spirit of respect and solidarity; it is likewise a renewed opportunity for us to further our understanding of their unique histories and to support the preservation of their languages, rich cultures, wisdom, spiritualities and traditions.

The Bishops of Canda, individually and collectively, continue to invite us to journey with Indigenous Peoples on the path that leads to truth, healing, justice, reconciliation and hope. Let us each accept this invitation by praying for reconciliation so that our relationships with Indigenous Peoples may continue to grow in trust and mutual respect for a brighter future for all.
