To continue the 100th Anniversary celebration of the Archdiocese of Winnipeg there will be a one-day Pilgrimage to four Sites as designated by Archbishop Richard Gagnon:

Participants will meet at St. Edward the Confessor Parish (836 Arlington St.) at 6:00 am for a light breakfast and registration. Transportation has been arranged with Beaver Bus Lines.

Cost is \$50/participant (payable on registration) and includes transportation, continental breakfast, lunch at Our Lady of Seven Sorrows Parish and dinner at Good Shepherd Parish in Portage la Prairie. If you wish to join the Pilgrimage but take your own vehicle, the cost is \$20/participant to cover meal costs.
