Anniversary of First Mass – Exactly 16 years ago, on Feb. 17, 2002, we celebrated the first Mass at St. Andrew School. Over 400 people attended. Right from the very beginning many people helped with the various ministries, from setting up chairs to helping with the liturgy itself. A number of people commented that although the Mass was being celebrated in a school gym, it really felt like a church. At the end of Mass everyone received a small packet with one mustard seed in it – a symbol of new

beginnings and the expected growth to take place in the future.

That mustard seed began to sprout and grow rapidly. As Jesus said, 'the mustard seed is the smallest of all the seeds, but when it has grown it is the biggest shrub of all and becomes a tree so that the birds of the air come and shelter in its branches.'

One tiny mustard seed now lies in the ground under the church.

Lenten Penance – Lent begins this week. It's time for penance, for almsgiving and prayer, for working to change attitudes that are not pleasing to God. We do penance during Lent for a variety of reasons. We are freely taking on suffering with Jesus for the salvation of the world in order to build up the Body of Christ. (see Col. 1:24) We express our sorrow for our own sins and offer prayer for others by the penance we undertake. By our penances God purifies our hearts and helps us to control our desires and so serve him in love. As we do our penitential actions during Lent, we are praising God and proclaiming that we are indeed God's people, brothers and sisters of the Suffering Servant.
