### Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

Today we celebrate the gift of the Eucharist, which is the centre, and the origin of the life of the Church. All Eucharistic devotion is related to the sacrifice of the Mass, which perpetuates Jesus' death and resurrection. It is a memorial of the Last Supper and an anticipation of the Messianic banquet in the Kingdom of heaven. Holy Thursday actually marks the institution of the Eucharist. But since it comes at a time when the commemoration of Jesus' passion and death overshadows everything else, the Church has given us this feast to bring out the joyous aspect of Holy Thursday, the gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. May we always give thanks to God for this wonderful gift.

"Lord Jesus Christ, we worship you living among us in the sacrament of your Body and Blood. May we offer to our Father in heaven a solemn pledge of undivided love. May we offer to our brothers and sisters a life poured out in loving service of that Kingdom where you live with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever."

Among those who were ordained, was our own parishioner, Roy Clifford Mayo. We congratulate Deacon Roy along with his wife Gladys and their family. He has been assigned as Deacon Assistant to Saint Clare of Assisi Parish in Woodbridge.

Twentieth Anniversary of the Founding of St. Padre Pio Parish – Twenty years ago, the beginning of the Parish of St. Padre Pio was celebrated as a two-day event on June 15/16, 2002. On Saturday, June 15, the World Youth Day Cross came to Woodbridge. After it arrived at Immaculate Conception Church, it was brought by truck to the new park on the southeast corner of Major Mackenzie and Islington Ave. This park is an historical site commemorating the journey of St. Jean de Brebeuf, possibly through this very area. A statue of St. Jean de Brebeuf and the native, Joseph Chihoatenhwa has been erected here, with the figure pointing toward the direction of the church. The ceremony at Le Parc St. Jeande-Brebeuf included the blessing of the park

by Monsignor Greg and an unveiling of a model of the new statue by the artist Antonio Caruso, one of our own parishioners. A model of the statue has also been donated to the Church of St. Padre Pio. The climax of the celebration was the arrival of the World Youth Day Cross at the park. The presence of the cross was very significant. The young people carrying the cross were called portageurs recalling the portages of aboriginal peoples and early Canadian missionaries such as St. Jean de Brebeuf. In memory of the fact that this was a portage area, the whole development has been called "Carrying Place." A sign with this designation is found outside the present Rectory. The World Youth Day cross was then brought to the site of the future St. Padre Pio Church, on the northwest corner of Major Mackenzie and Islington. After the welcoming of the Cross and opening prayer, a special blessing to dedicate the site as 'holy ground' was said. Also, a new sign, indicating that this is the future site of St. Padre Pio Church was unveiled. At the end of the ceremony, hundreds of balloons were released. On Sunday, June 16<sup>th</sup>, a special Mass was celebrated at St. Andrew School. At the opening of the Mass, the Papal Bull of the Canonization of Padre Pio and the Decree of the Official Establishment of the Parish of St. Padre Pio was read, followed by a Letter of Appointment of Father Greg as the new Pastor. Then the unveiling and blessing of the new statue of St. Padre Pio took place. At the end of Mass, the new relic of St. Padre Pio was presented with a special blessing given. Everyone then congregated outside where 36 doves were released. As we continue to move forward, we ask God's blessings on all the families and members of our Parish of St. Padre Pio.

Prayer for our Parish - "Blessed are you, Lord God, King of the universe: we praise you for calling us to be your people, and for saving us in Jesus Christ your son. Bless the people of this parish and help us to grow in your love. Let our lives and our worship be pleasing to you. 
