**Ordinary Time** – During ordinary time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God praise Him by celebrating the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. On the first day of the week, the Lord's day, God assembles His beloved people to hear His word, to reflect upon it, to offer a living sacrifice of praise, to eat and drink the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions. Sunday is the original Christian feast day, following the tradition handed down from the apostles' time, for this was the day of the Lord's Resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the Risen Lord.

**Reopening of Churches** – The churches have now reopened at 15% capacity. Daily Masses and the weekend Masses have resumed. The 15% capacity means that once the two centre sets of pews have been filled, that is full capacity, and no one else may enter the church, by law. We hope that, eventually, church capacity will increase as we slowly get back to normal.

**Confessions** – have now returned to their normal times on Saturday from 4:00pm to 4:30pm and on Thursday evenings from 6:30pm to 7:00pm.

**Confirmations** – Since the schools are not reopening until September, the July dates for Confirmations will be maintained. There will be four Confirmation Masses during the week of July 5<sup>th</sup> for the classes of 2020. Parents should have already received notice of their particular date and time.
