### **Canada Day – July 1**

July 1<sup>st</sup> is celebrated as Canada's birthday. A contemporary Christian should seek a responsible world view rather than a narrow nationalism, seeing our homeland as part of the family of nations. Canadians should seek to be witnesses to Christ in Canada and the world, and to continue working to influence those in government to act from Christian principals and attitudes. Christians, realizing they do not have a lasting home there, should pray and work for justice and peace in Canada and throughout the world, so that all God's people may share in the goods of this earth. God's Kingdom will come only when all people are ready to let Jesus' teaching guide and rule their lives and actions.

*"Lord Jesus Christ, look on the people of our land and bless us all. Help us to be brothers and sisters to all the world, and to work for peace and love. Be with us Jesus, and bless Canada, for you are our Lord and Saviour for ever". Amen*

**Ordinary Time** – During ordinary time, the Church celebrates the fullness of the mystery of the Lord Jesus. The people of God praise Him by celebrating the paschal mystery of the death and resurrection of Jesus. On the first day of the week, the Lord's Day, God assembles His beloved people to hear His Word, to reflect upon it, to offer a living sacrifice of praise, to eat and drink at the banquet of the Lord. Then God sends them forth to proclaim this love by their words and actions. Sunday is the original Christian feast day, following the tradition handed down from the apostles' time, for this was the day of the Lord's resurrection. Today's Christian communities continue this tradition by celebrating every Sunday as the day of the Risen Lord.
