## NO WEEKDAY MASSES WHILE ON HOLIDAYS MASS SCHEDULE IN OTHER PARISHES

Please be aware that there are no weekday masses here during Augus 26-29. Parishioners who have intentions booked during that time should have been contacted by now to reschedule those intentions or have them fulfilled by Fr. Dave during the masses he celebrates while on holidays.

Parishioners who wish to attend morning mass are encouraged to attend one of the other parishes in Burlington: St. John the Baptist, St. Raphael, St. Gabriel or St.. Paul the Apostle. Most of these parishes have more than one priest and are able to continue their regular mass schedules. Call the parish or check online for the weekday mass schedule for each of these parishes.

## TIP TAP SYSTEM NOW INSTALLED AND HOW IT WORKS

The parish recognizes that many people today don't carry physical cash as frequently as they once did. To address this shift, we have introduced **TipTap®** devices, which are contactless payment terminals that allow parishioners and visitors to tap their credit or debit cards to make donations. These devices allow users to tap their credit or debit card for a set amount (\$5, \$10, or \$20). Many parishes now offer this method of donating.

While tax receipts are not typically issued for these donations, it is possible for us to do so. Please contact our office if you'd like to inquire about receiving one. The service we use is looking to introduce tax receipting in Canada this fall.

These devices are now installed in the main entrance of the church on a stand on the right-hand side of the hallway, beside the bookcase as you leave the church.

To donate, simply tap your credit card, debit card or other payment method on the device (or a combination of devices) displaying the amount you wish to donate. One beep will sound to indicate the card has been read, and another beep will follow a few seconds to indicate the payment has been completed. Two beeps after the initial beep suggest there was a problem, and the user should tap again or use a different card. Three beeps mean the card was declined.

These devices are secure and convenient. Only the last four digits of your card are visible in our records and no information about the cardholder are revealed to us. No transaction receipt is issued for the donation. Your bank or credit card statement will simply indicate a donation to Holy Rosary Church.

We hope parishioners and visitors will find this a convenient method of donating to the parish community.
