WORLD DAY OF THE SICK FEBRUARY 11, 2025

The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11, the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the great efforts of doctors, nurses, healthcareinstitutions and pastoral caregivers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.

Who is eligible to receive the Sacrament of the Sick?

The Sacrament of the Sick, also known as the Anointing of the Sick, is a sacrament in the Catholic Church that is intended for those who are seriously ill or in danger of death due to sickness or old age. Here are some key points about eligibility:

Serious Illness: Those who are suffering from a serious illness, whether physical or mental, are eligible.

Elderly: Elderly individuals who are experiencing the frailties of old age can receive the sacrament.

Imminent Surgery: Those who are about to undergo major surgery due to a serious illness.

Repeated Reception: The sacrament can be received more than once, especially if the person's condition worsens or if they recover and then fall ill again. It's a sacrament for those in need of healing and comfort, offering spiritual strength and grace.

On Tuesday, February 11, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. we will celebrate the Mass of the Anointing of the Sick for those who wish to be anointed and are suffering from an ongoing or serious illness, are struggling with feebleness of age or are plagued by addictions and are sincerely striving to overcome them, or other diseases of body, soul or mind. Please use the signup sheet in the main foyer to receive the Sacrament of the Sick at this mass.
