

### WORLD DAY OF THE SICK FEBRUARY 11, 2025

#### MASS OF THE ANOINTING OF THE SICK - 7:00 P.M.

The ministry of Jesus to the sick is central to the life of the Church. February 11, the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes) highlights the healing ministry of the Church. It reminds us that service to the sick and suffering cannot be neglected. It recognizes the outstanding efforts of doctors, nurses, healthcare institutions and pastoral caregivers to restore health to those afflicted with illness and disease.

Suffering and illness have always been among the most significant problems that trouble the human spirit, yet the gift of faith helps us grasp the mystery of suffering more deeply and bear pain with greater courage. Believers know that sickness has meaning and value for our salvation and the world's salvation. Much of Jesus' ministry in the gospels is dedicated to those sick or suffering from severe afflictions.

Although closely linked to the human condition, sickness is not a general rule regarded as a punishment for sin. Even Jesus, who was without sin, shared in human pain.

Part of God's providential plan is to fight against all sickness and see the blessings of good health, so that we may fulfill our role in human society and the Church.

Moreover, the role of the sick in the Church is to remind others of the essential or higher things. By their witness, the ill show that our moral life must be redeemed through the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection.

The Letter of James states that the sick are to be anointed to raise and save them. Great care and concern should be taken to see that those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age receive this sacrament.

Balance is needed in determining who is eligible to receive this sacrament *On the one hand, the sacrament may and should be given to anyone whose health is seriously impaired; on the other hand, it may not be given indiscriminately or to any person whose health is not seriously impaired.* Seriously sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this sacrament, usually around the age of 7 or 8 years of age.

#### Who is eligible to receive the Sacrament of the Sick?

**Serious Illness:** Those suffering from a severe physical or mental illness are eligible. This may include those who are sincerely striving to overcome an addiction and are seeking divine assistance.

**Elderly:** Elderly individuals experiencing the frailties of old age can receive the sacrament.

**Imminent Surgery**: Those who are about to undergo major surgery due to a serious illness.

Repeated Reception: The sacrament can be received more than once, significantly if the person's condition worsens or they recover and then fall ill again. It's a sacrament for those in need of healing and comfort, offering spiritual strength and grace.

We request that those who wish to receive this Sacrament pre-register for the anointing. Please use the sign-up sheet in the main foyer to receive the Sacrament of the Sick at this mass.
