

COLD AND FLU SEASON PRECAUTIONS

As all are aware, we are in the height of the cold and flu season with a higher than normal number of people suffering from colds and flu. There are some simple things we can do to help minimize the spread of the flu: if you are

sick. The first is to stay home! We are not bound to the Sunday obligation if we are sick . Second, at mass, many people are particularly sensitive to the spreading of germs through contact. At the sign of peace, it is perfectly acceptable to offer and receive a verbal expression of peace without shaking hands. Do not be offended if someone near you does not wish to shake hands - they are not being rude, but cautious! To help minimize the spread of germs we have placed some bottles of hand sanitizer in the washrooms/main foyer. Please feel free to use this product when you enter and leave the church during the cold and flu season.
