

Pyxes for Communion--Lately I have been going out to make communion calls and visits to some of the sick and in the hospital; however, we are short on pyxes at this time. If you are not doing a permanent ministry to the sick or a loved one, we need you to return the pyxes ASAP. First of all, there may be others who need to borrow a pyx who have been commissioned to bring communion to the sick. Second, sometimes there are fragments of Jesus left in the pyx, and so must be returned so we can properly purify them for future use. Also, we ask that when you take communion to the sick, it must be the same day--no one is allowed to keep Jesus overnight in their homes or on their person without my express consent. We are in need of more ministers of communion to the sick, as we now potentially have a few people who require that ministry and are unable to go to church. 
