



He called the house "L'Arche," a French word for "the ark" in the biblical story of Noah and the flood. L'Arche Winnipeg was founded in 1973 and Kevin has lived there since 1979. The L'Arche Winnipeg Walkathon takes place May 3<sup>rd</sup> and the Hanson and (Sean & Lisa) O'Hara families, along with many cousins, nieces and nephews, will be walking as Team Hurry Up Hanson.
