





Gaudete (Third Sunday of Advent)

Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus.

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18

This Sunday, called Gaudete (Latin for "rejoice"), marks the halfway point of Advent. The rose candle is lit, and the second reading begins, "Rejoice always!" This upbeat mood can come to a full stop, however, when the requirement extends to giving thanks in all circumstances. I remember my friend suffering blinding headaches after her third cesarean section, was also dealing with her crying unborn, the head lice her son brought home from kindergarten and sewage overflow in her house after a ball had flushed down the toilet. She cried, "If I have one more circumstance, I will be giving thanks in a institution!"

I'm convinced the only thing that gets us through terrible times is "prayer without ceasing." This is not thanking God that this chaos is God's will, but that we are not alone.
