

Dear parishioners,

By now some of you heard of the provincial governments next steps in the safe reopening plan, which include the reopening of places of worship to 10% capacity or 50 people, whichever is the lesser.

We will reopen for Ash Wednesday, and we will have two Masses, one at 1030 AM (which will be shared with St. Charles School by Zoom) and one at 7PM in the evening. The limit for both Masses will be 30 people in keeping with the guidelines. We will be taking registration for those Masses. We will have a regular morning weekday Mass at 9AM, Wed-Fri (all Masses at the Church for now as Chemin Neuf is too small to keep the health orders). The Sunday Mass schedule will be released on the long weekend.

It will be necessary to register for weekend Masses and special Masses such as Ash Wednesday. You will not need to register for regular weekday Masses (unless demand is extremely high).

Our first weekend Masses will occur on the weekend of Feb. 20-21 We will begin taking registration for Masses starting Mon. Feb. 15th.
