



Francis, in part of his 2017 Christmas Homily, said: "That night, the One who had no place to be born was proclaimed to those who had no place at the table or



in the streets of the city. The shepherds were the first to hear the Good News. By reason of their work, they were men and women forced to live on the edges of society. Their state of life, and the places they had to stay, prevented them from observing all the ritual prescriptions of religious purification; as a result, they were considered unclean. Their skin, their clothing, their smell, their way of speaking, their origin, all betrayed them. Everything about them generated mistrust. They were men and women to be kept at a distance, to be feared." Do we fear the forced migrants? The refugees from places like Syria, Myanmar, Guatemala or Honduras? Do we understand that the reasons they are fleeing include armed conflict, ethnic and religious persecution, drought, food insecurity and environmental degradation, just to note a few. Are we willing to accept our brothers and sisters no matter what the colour of their skin or their reasons for fleeing their homelands? There is one way that we can take action right TODAY WE CAN SIGN THE ACTION CARD AT THE now. BACK OF THE CHURCH WHICH WILL BE SENT TO OUR PRIME MINISTER requesting that Canada provide more humanitarian aid for refugees and their host countries and that Canada support grassroots organizations working for peace, democracy and human rights.
