



- 1. Reverend Kelly Wilson as the Director of Synod Implementation. (This appointment is in addition to his appointment as Parochial Vicar of St. Gianna's Parish in Winnipeg.) As you know our formal Synod came to a conclusion on Pentecost Sunday. The next phase will focus on making plans for the implementation of the recommendations made by the Synod.
- 2. Very Reverend Eric Zadji as Dean or Vicar Forane of South Winnipeg Deanery.

Personnel change:

1. Reverend Piotr Jan Dudek, OMI becomes Parochial Vicar of Holy Ghost Parish in Winnipeg (effective September 1, 2018). We are grateful for the service of Reverend Daniel Janulewicz, OMI for his ministry at Holy Ghost Parish since 2014.

We are all aware that the means of communicating have changed rapidly over the past number of years. There is no doubt that the majority of people receive their information via some form of social media. Many dioceses across Canada have been restructuring their communications Departments to reflect this new reality. There has also been a precipitous drop in the number of diocesan newspapers. For ourselves, the recent Synod recommended that as an Archdiocese, we review our means of communicating.

A Note about Pastoral Care during the summer months:

Fr. Michael will be away for about 8 weeks (for studies and holidays) starting Thurs. June 28th. During this time, Ron Labbe and Richard Nichol, our trustees, will be in charge of all financial and temporal matters for the parish. Deacon Robert and Deacon Claude are in charge of pastoral care (sacraments, funerals etc.). If there is a death in the parish or need for a funeral, please contact the parish office, who in turn will get in touch with the deacons. If you are working with a funeral home, please ask them to assist in finding a priest for the funeral if you are having a funeral Mass. If the funeral does not include a Mass, the Deacons are able to do the funeral liturgy. Due to the length of Fr. Michael's absence, it was not possible to create a schedule of priests on call for emergencies or funerals. There is a priest on call for the Grace Hospital every day and night of the week. At HSC, there is a chaplain on-site during the day during the week, and Tues, through Fri evenings and overnight, there are priests on call for emergencies. Seven Oaks Hospital has priests on call every day and night of the week.

We will have a priest to say Mass for all the weekend Masses during the time Fr. Michael is away. If you know you are going to hospital for surgery or other procedures, feel free to be proactive and ask them for the Sacrament of the Sick. There will not be any weekday Masses during this time. Also, Adoration and Holy Hours will be cancelled during the summer months.

If you are looking for a baptism, contact the parish office. The priests that are coming to say Mass are able to do baptisms during Mass; however, all baptisms must be cleared through the office as some have already been booked for some weekends already.

A note from Fr. Michael—I want to thank everyone for their prayers and support. I will be headed to Detroit soon to begin Year 3 of the Licentiate in the New Evangelization. I am looking forward to the opportunity to grow in faith with over 40 colleagues from the U.S., India, Argentina, the Netherlands, and China. Please pray for me and all of us in studies and be assured that I will offer Mass for you as a community and continue to pray for you. Blessings to you all and have a great summer!!
