

Parish Ministry Needs: At this time, we are in need of a safe environment coordinator or a team of two coordinators--this is an essential ministry in order to ensure a safe environment for minors and vulnerable persons in ministry and in our parish. The term would be for three years. People responsible would oversee that all in ministry have the appropriate checks done

(police and child abuse registry), to ensure that all who are involved in ministry to minors and vulnerable persons receive training with respect to safe environments and other reviews or jobs as required by the archdiocese and or insurance company. Anyone who is interested should contact Fr. Michael or the parish office.

Also, we are looking for new members for the Parish Pastoral Council and a new chair for the PPC, as Marianne Meush will be retiring from this role by the end of 2017. Anyone who is interested in being a member of the council may contact Fr. Michael or the pastoral office. Those who seek to be on the PPC are expected to attend a monthly meeting, held normally on the first Thursday of every month. Members advise Fr. Michael on spiritual and pastoral matters, helping to develop a pastoral plan to meet the needs of the community. This is a consultative board. Members would be asked to consider a term of three years(renewable) to give stability to the PPC. In this parish, the custom is that members would be appointed by the Pastor, along with the discernment/consultation of the PPC. People can recommend to Fr. Michael, the PPC chair or any member of PPC someone they feel would be good for the council though Fr. Michael and members of the PPC will be willing to make contact with those individuals. No previous experience is required for being a member of PPC, though preference is given to those who are involved in ministry and present to the community in a regular way (such as attending Mass). There are some spots on council that are taken up by reps from various groups in order to help us stay in touch with various ministries and groups. You may send recommendations to Fr. Michael or Marianne Meush.

As for the chair, the chair meets with Fr. Michael to prepare the agendas for the PPC meetings and is responsible to facilitate the meetings, ensuring flow and order. If there is someone who has that talent and has a love for the parish, please contact Fr. Michael or Marianne Meush. Mentoring/training can be provided.

Thank you for praying about these important needs and being willing to assist to help our parish to grow. In the future there will be more about opportunities for ministry.
