

St. Charles Cemetery – The cost of purchasing plots and niches in the columbarium are increasing effective July 1, 2016 to cover our obligation for perpetual care of the cemetery. Parishioners can take advantage of today's rates up to June 30, 2016 by purchasing a plot for a flat marker (\$700.00), a plot for an upright marker (\$850.00) or a columbarium niche (\$1250.00). Purchases can be arranged by contacting Assumption Cemetery at 204-888-7557. Effective July 1, 2016 a plot for a flat marker will be \$1200.00; plot for an upright marker \$1500.00 and a niche \$1700.00.

On **July 1, 2016** we will be pre-selling niches in the new columbarium which is expected to be completed this fall. The pre-sell cost of a niche in the new columbarium will be \$1700.00 and these can be purchased directly from the parish. More information will follow in the coming weeks.

All money from the sale of plots, niches and the pre-sale of any new niches are deposited into the St. Charles Cemetery Trust Fund for the care and maintenance of our cemetery.

ELEVATOR UPDATE: To date there are 66 pledges with a commitment of \$102,624.00 over the next 5 years. The Elevator Trust Fund currently has a balance of \$15,243.24. The logistics for making your donation thru Pre-authorized debit (PAD) have been worked out and will start in **July 2016**. Forms are available in the foyer office if you would like to make your elevator donations thru PAD. It is asked that you start making your elevator donations if you have not already done so. Thank you to those who have made donations to date. Please be sure to clearly mark your envelopes/cheques "Elevator Fund" so the donation is appropriately deposited. Thank you for your support.
