**Development and Peace-Share Lent 2013 Human Dignity-
More than Ever**

Human dignity is the right for women to participate in
society. Ms. Gulandam, 50, lives with her husband and 12
children in the province of Kapisa in Afghanistan, a region
that has been the site of violent fighting between coalition
military forces and Taliban fighters in the ongoing war in the
country. Struggling to provide for her family she began to
search for work, but it was not an easy endeavor. In a
society where women have few rights and there is cultural
resistance to their participation in the workforce, hardly any
opportunities existed. Fortunately, she came across a food
processing company being supported by D & P partner THE
AFGHAN WOMEN'S RESOURCE CENTRE (AWRC). She
began to receive technical training and two years later was
chosen to become a group leader in heading up a local
women's business that produces pickles, vegetable sauce
and peppers. The AWRC also provided her with a micro-
credit loan so she could purchase equipment for her
business. Her business success did not end there. With
the continued support of the AWRC, she received training in
marketing to help improve the sale of her products, and
joined a women's cooperative. "I am proud to be working
and running a small business in my village", she said. "I'm
proud that I can help my family and other women in the
community." The opportunity afforded to her by the AWRC,
our partner, did make a difference! You helped to make
that difference by your donation last year. We ask that you
