

Andre who got a termite exterminator. He had to come from Port au Prince with the product!!! Now we have to organize the books back on the shelves. We also noticed some deterioration of the ceiling in the cafeteria...Fr.had that repaired. It was well worth hauling our suitcases with the supplies, books, games. The children are enjoying them and having a great time. This weekend we will paint rocks..should be interesting how that will go. Celebrations for the Carnival were cancelled throughout the country to prevent any riots and bloodshed. There are always incidents happening in Port au Prince. In the North where we are the situation is calm. When we arrived in Cap Haitian I was the last one to go through the Customs. The agent charged me \$60, then lowered it to \$50. He refused my Credit Card, wanting cash. Fr. Andre said that this was fraud as this agent would use this money for his own personal use. I guess this is all part of the adventure!!! Please continue to keep us and the Haitian people in your prayers. Love Louise
