



Saturday, November 4, 2017 Feast Day of St. Charles Borromeo Patron Saint of Catechists

"Be sure that you first preach by the way you live"-St. Charles Borromeo

St. Charles Borromeo was born on October 2, 1538 in Arona, Italy. He was Archbishop of Milan from 1564 to 1584 and a Cardinal. He is credited for his contribution to counter-reformation of the Catholic Church as well as the development of formal catechism. Although he was born into a wealthy family and well educated, he used his knowledge of canon law and his family connection to the Pope (Pius IV was his uncle) to address corruption within the upper leadership of the church which had strayed from core Catholic teachings.

St. Charles had a daunting task ahead of him as Milan was the largest archdiocese in Italy at that time. Convincing the clergy to reform their ways and return to authentic Catholic Church teaching was not easy and he was resisted and disliked on several fronts. The clergy was accused of buying positions and being "lazy and ignorant", not even knowing how to administer the sacraments. Leading by example he refused a self-serving lifestyle of a lavish household and staff or payment for his service within the church. Rather, *he served* the poor by providing food and shelter; he established hospitals, colleges and orphanages and raised charity. St. Charles' tough love approach led to several prominent society members being excommunicated due to their refusal to follow strict reformed rules. No one was above the new law(s)-fairness was preached.

Further to reforming the attitudes of the clergy and their perceived roles, he also firmly believed in the *education of the laity* at the grassroots level which included establishing "740 schools, three thousand catechists, and forty thousand students in Sunday schools". He wrote extensively including catechism texts, music, and liturgy pieces. He was canonized in 1610.

St. Charles Borromeo reminds us to re-examine the teachings of the Gospels and look within ourselves. We need to "walk the talk", be humble and not hypocritical, serve others as Christ came to serve and to continually educate ourselves in our faith.


