Family, Parish, School

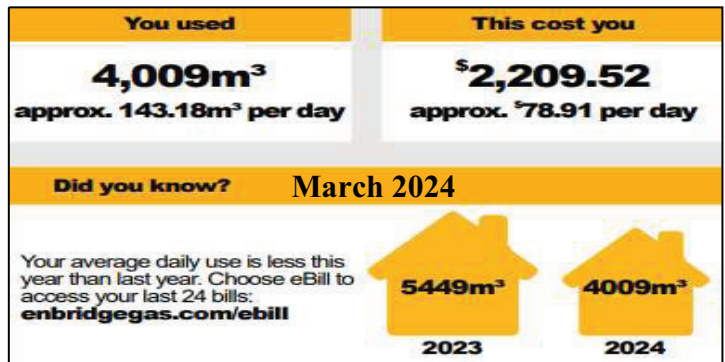
First Holy Communion at St. John's is on April 28.
