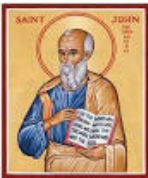

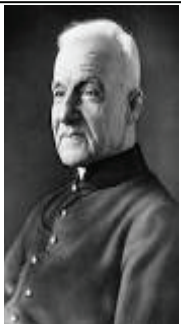

FEAST OF THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD - August 6

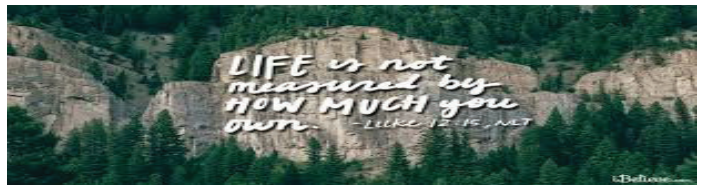

Sacristan Position

The duties require the laundering and upkeep of all vestments, linens used for Mass, altar cloths, altar servers' robes, choir members' robes, sacred vessels and everything required for the upkeep of the sanctuaries of the Cathedral and St. James' Chapel. Other duties would involve setting up for Sunday Masses and being present at the 10:30 am Sunday Mass at the Cathedral, at any celebration for which the Archbishop is present, and for funerals and weddings. Applicants should have good physical stamina, be pleasant to the public and have a certain degree of versatility, which dealing with the public requires. Interested applicants should understand the practice of the Catholic Faith. Applicants must be very particular about cleanliness.
