**Let us pray that children suffering from incurable diseases and their families receive the necessary medical care and support, never losing strength and hope.**

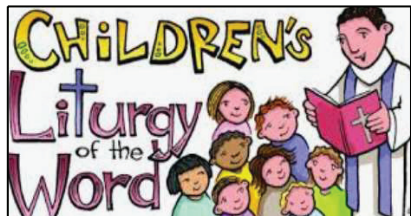
