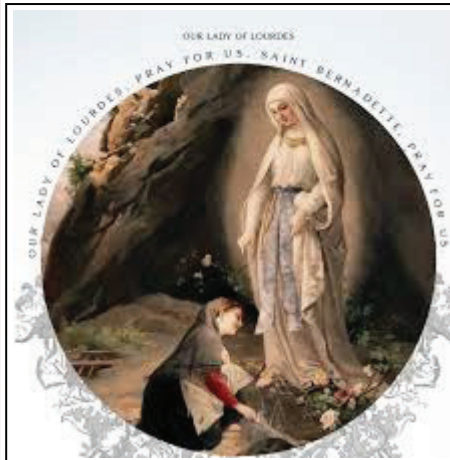
**READINGS FOR February 13, Sixth Sunday in

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 1

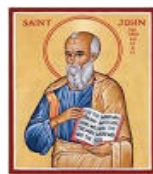
Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 15.12, 16-20

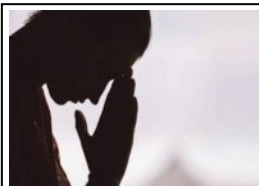
