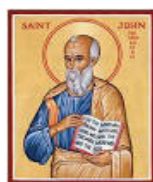
Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 2.6-10

The Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick is a very important part of the Church life because Jesus reaches out his love to those who are very sick, frail and near to death.

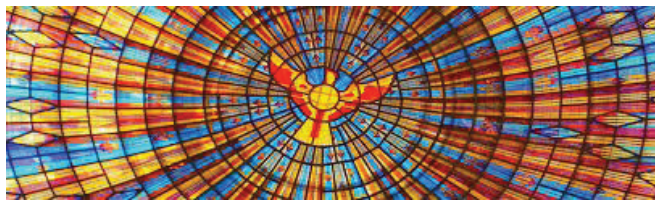

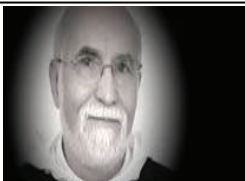
