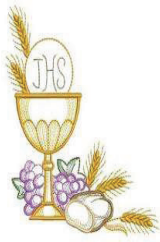
PRAYERS AT THE END OF MASS

The next regular CWL meeting will be held in the sacristy at St. John's on **February 19, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.** Everyone is welcome.



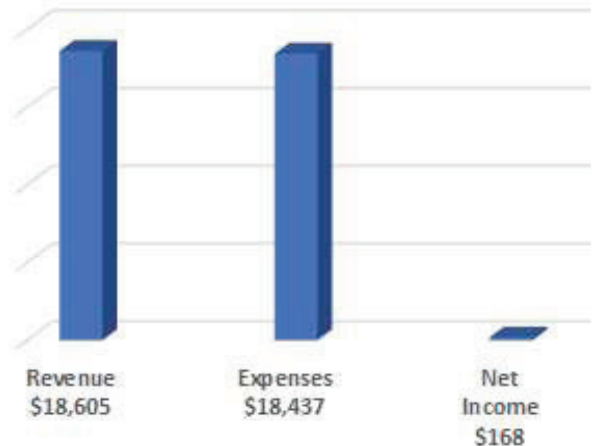
