May you use those gifts that you have received, and pass

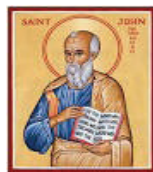

MESSAGE FROM FR. DALE REGARDING THE SYNOD

My Friends in Christ:

Last year Pope Francis announced a Synod that will take place in two years time, that will deal with the future of the Church and the challenges that confront it. As a part of this synodal process, the Universal Church will be consulted through the use of an online survey. Each Diocese throughout the world, including ours, will receive this survey and will pass the results on. The Canadian Council of Catholic Bishops will then summarize and forward to Vatican officials.

As I said, the survey can be viewed online at <https://romancatholic.kingston.on.ca/synod> (there is also a link on our website) and we will also provide printed copies for those who desire them. These copies, once filled out can be forwarded to the Parish Office and we will pass them on to the Archdiocese. The deadline to submit the survey, either online or hard copy is April 1, 2022. It is important the survey should be done in a spirit of prayer, as well as reflection.

We will pray that this process will be guided by the Holy Spirit, as Pope Francis has asked each of us to do. We will also pray for the Church, during this period of consultation and discernment. A prayer for this synodal process has been printed in both the bulletin and on our website.

I would like to thank you for your prayers and support of this Synod and I am hopeful that in the future, it will bear good fruit for our Church and all people of God.
