Saint Francis de Sales - January 24:

Leader of the Catholic Reformation, born in France, 1567. After obtaining doctorates in both canon and civil law by the age of 24.

He chose religious life instead. Francis was beatified the year he died 1622 the first

formal beatification to take place in St. Peter's and canonized in 1665. He is patron saint of writers and journalists, and the deaf.

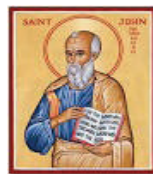


Conversion of Saint Paul - January 25:

was a turning point in the history of the early Church. Saul, as Paul was first known, zealously persecuted the followers of Christ.

He was struck down amidst a blinding light from heaven. He then headed to Damascus

and began proclaiming Jesus. Paul's zeal for the risen Jesus led him to become a passionate follower and teacher of nations. The letters or epistles, of Paul offer us a window into the early Church.
