- Give a gift of a Mass for someone's birthday, to someone who is ill or undergoing surgery. Envelopes located at Church entrance.

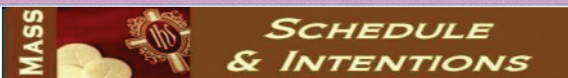

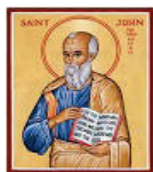
Gospel: Mark 6.30-34

It is used in the

Just as the crops are dependent upon summer rains not only to grow but to survive so our spiritual development is dependent upon our frequenting the sacraments and receiving the Blood of Christ.

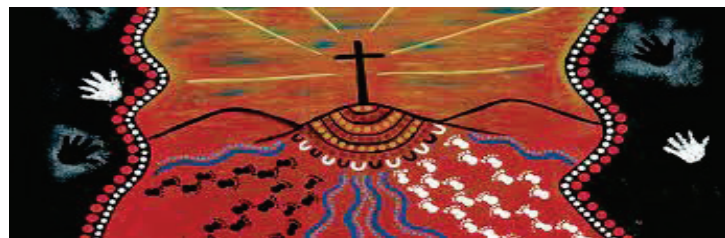

POPE FRANCIS is "in good, overall condition, alert" and breathing on his own after undergoing a three-hour operation that involved removing half of his colon.

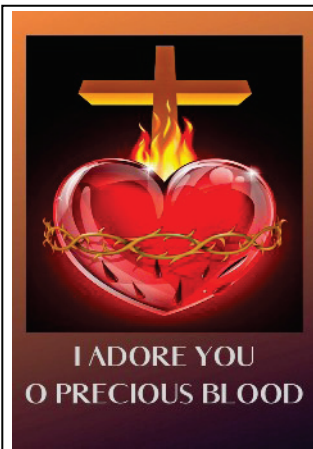
