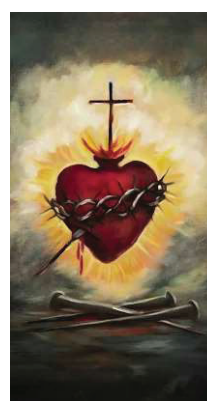


For formation in discernment
