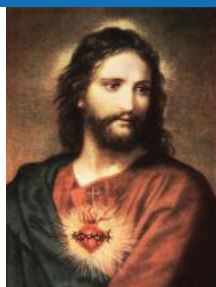
**PRAYER FOR ETERNAL LIFE:**
