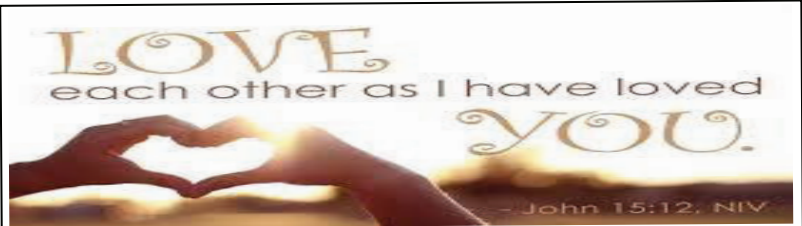

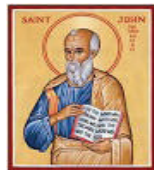

As you Celebrate your First Communion today, remember that God's love will always be there to comfort you, guide you and bless you.

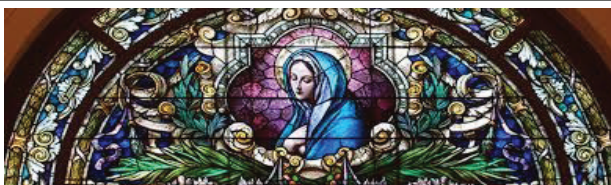


New Life Support Group Meetings
