- Give a gift of a Mass for someone's birthday, to someone who is ill or undergoing surgery. Envelopes located at Church entrance.

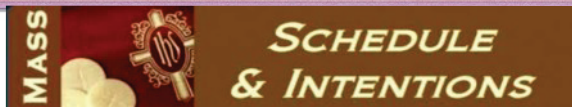

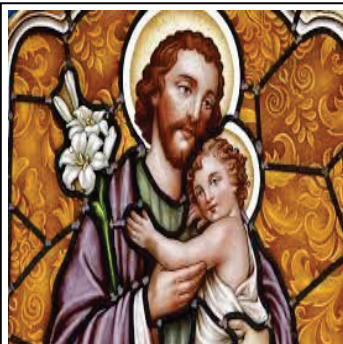

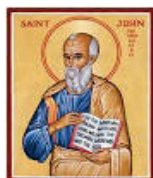
The Christian custom of dedicating the month of May to the Blessed Virgin arose at the end of the 13th century. The practice was granted a partial indulgence by Pius VII in 1815 and a plenary indulgence by

Pius IX in 1859. The Blessed Virgin Mary is the Mother of the Church and therefore the example, as well as the guide and inspiration, of everyone who, in and through the Church, seeks to be the servant of God and man and the obedient agent of the promptings of the Holy Spirit.



After the Blessed Virgin Mary, St. Joseph is the greatest of the saints. He is the one "into whose custody God entrusted his most precious treasures," Jesus and Mary. Joseph is the one whom God chose to be the "overseer of the Lord's birth", the one who has the responsibility to look after the

Son of God's "ordained" entry into the world, in accordance with divine dispositions and human laws. *"If you want to be close to Christ, I repeat to you 'Ite ad Ioseph': Go to Joseph!" - Ven. Pius XII*

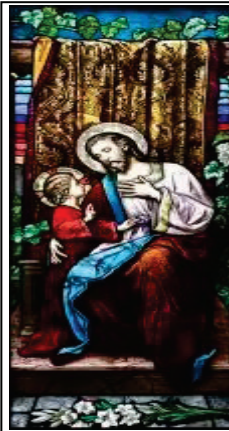


FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
