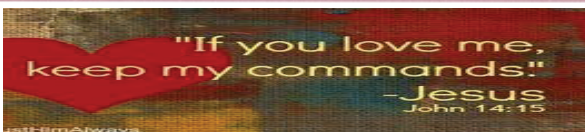

Responsorial Psalm: Psalm 67

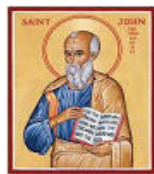
